## **Pannonian Treasure Pet Nat**

Deuric, FRUŠKA GORA

A naturally sparkling wine from Serbia, crafted exclusively from Sauvignon Blanc using the ancestral method. Bottled before fermentation is complete, it develops gentle, natural bubbles and a lively, fresh character.

On the nose, it shows bright citrus, green apple, and elderflower, alongside subtle herbal notes typical of Sauvignon Blanc.

## **SEVERNA MORAVA, 2023**

DEURIĆ, FRUŠKA GORA

Severna Morava is a native variety which is now only grown by a few remaining wineries. The grape is named after the Great Morava river which runs through Serbia. The saltiness and high minerality of the variety cause people to liken it a little to Chablis, but with more tropical fruits and a moreish, juicy finish.

## **AMFORA, 2017**

VINČIĆ, FRUŠKA GORA

One of the best orange wines to come out of Serbia. Made from 100% Grasac and aged in clay amphora, the way wine has been made for centuries. Fresh, fine minerality, a salty touch with orange zest, limey fruit and plenty of white peach.

## **Doja Prokupac**

Toplice Region

A modern expression of Serbia's indigenous grape Prokupac, showcasing both tradition and freshness. Sourced from carefully selected vineyards, this wine highlights the true character of this historic Balkan variety. On the nose, it offers ripe red cherry, wild strawberry, and subtle spice, with a gentle earthy undertone.

The palate is medium-bodied, smooth, and vibrant, with soft tannins and bright acidity

## **PROBUS 276, 2021**

DEURIĆ, FRUŠKA GORA

Named after the Roman Emperor - Marcus Aurelius Probus - who brought the first grapes to Serbia. 276 AD is the year he was appointed emperor. The wine is big in body, with firm tannins and plenty of red and black fruits. It's always a favourite for those who like a heavier style of red.

## **BLACK TAMJANIKA, 2023**

MATALJ, NEGOTIN

Black Tamjanika is native variety to Serbia. This version is 'late harvested' which means it stays on the vine for longer and retains more sweetness. It's what's called on off-dry style. With red berried and rose petal on the palate, its great for pairing with sweeter treats.
